



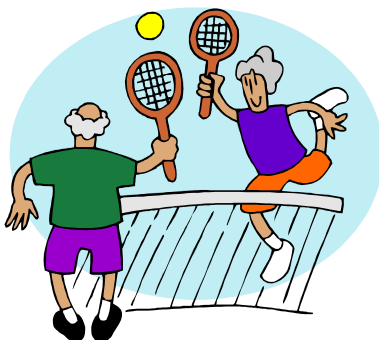
# Want to Enjoy Your Tennis More?

We pride ourselves on being a friendly and informal club, and in an effort to promote this, the committee suggests that this common sense advice will actually help you and you fellow members enjoy tennis more.

Please take a minute to read the following. Many thanks.

- Be accommodating during the warm-up, and be ready to play after no more than five minutes
- Always ensure that the server is kept supplied with balls, and be ready to play when the server is ready
- Never walk behind or go onto another court whilst a point is in play – please enter Courts 3 and 4 via the garden when there is play on courts 1 and 2
- Wait until play has stopped to return any stray ball from an adjoining court, and always wait for a ball to be returned, do not retrieve it
- Do not practice returns on long serves or otherwise hit the ball aggressively when a point is not in play
- The server should call the score after every point and after every game
- Immediately 'take two' if a stray ball interferes with play
- All tennis at the club is self umpiring so it is usually more sociable not to get involved with disputes, again 'take two' if any disagreement occurs

Most importantly, try to make the game as enjoyable for everyone on court as possible.
